Working with acclaimed winemaker, Philippe Langer, who started his career in France before settling in the Atlas Peak appellation of Napa Valley, the fruit for the Poiema Pinot Noir comes from cool coastal vineyards in Sonoma.

Artist Bio

The 'Poiema' painting was done by artist, James Caprell. Born in 1976 in San Jose, CA Caprell is a 1st generation Armenian American. After graduating from DePauw University, he moved to New York City for an investment banking job. After a few years on Wall Street, Caprell left to pursue the arts. He remained in New York for ten years where he exhibited privately from his Harlem and Manhattan studios and also from galleries in Miami and Atlanta and before he moved back to California where he works out of his studio in Los Angeles.

Wine Tasting Notes



Poiema Pinot Noir: Aromas of black cherry and cola with floral notes lead to a lush palate of ripe cherry, pomegranate, dark fruit, spice and vanilla. This wine drinks beautifully by itself, and is delightfully food friendly.

Varietal: 100% Pinot Noir

Aged in French Oak barrels for 9-12 months. 14.1% alcohol.
